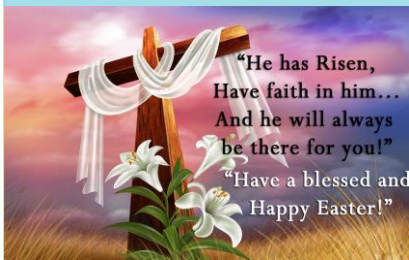

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

The Annual meeting of Calvary Lutheran Church was held on March 6 2022 after services. The meeting was called to order by President Elmyrna Kaupang.

The meeting opened with a prayer. There was no annual meeting last year so there were no minutes to read. The treasurer's report was presented and accepted. The budget for this year was presented. There was a motion made by Floyd Balstad to accept the proposed budget, it was seconded by Dale Balstad and passed. Marissa McWilliam Donner was commended on her work as the church office secretary. It was suggested to have a meeting with the board of the 3-point Parish to discuss the settlement for the last year.

A discussion on the development of a Cemetery Association was held. Dale Balstad read from the drafts of the Articles of Incorporation and the By-Laws documents that have been drawn up by a Lawyer. Dale Balstad made a motion to proceed with the process of establishing a Cemetery Association. The motion was seconded by Floyd Balstad and passed.

A motion to accept the complete ballot that was presented was made by Dale Balstad and seconded by Gary Sonstrelie . It passed. A copy of the ballot is attached to the minutes.

The meeting was adjourned. It was closed with the Lord's Prayer.

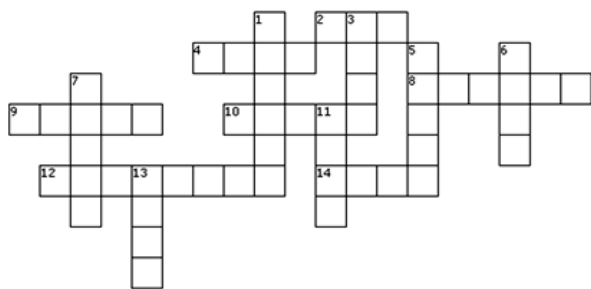

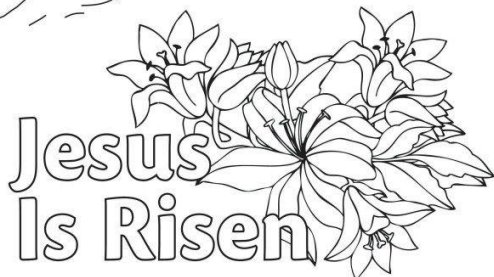
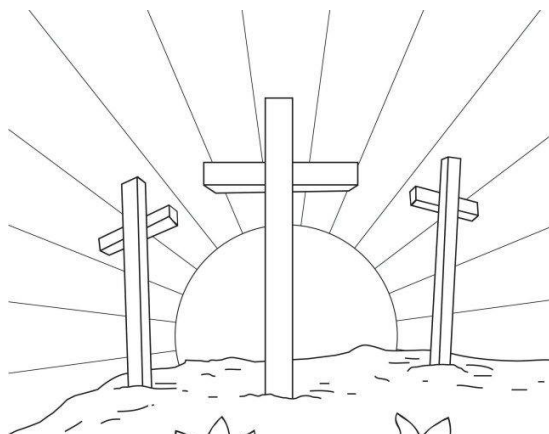
