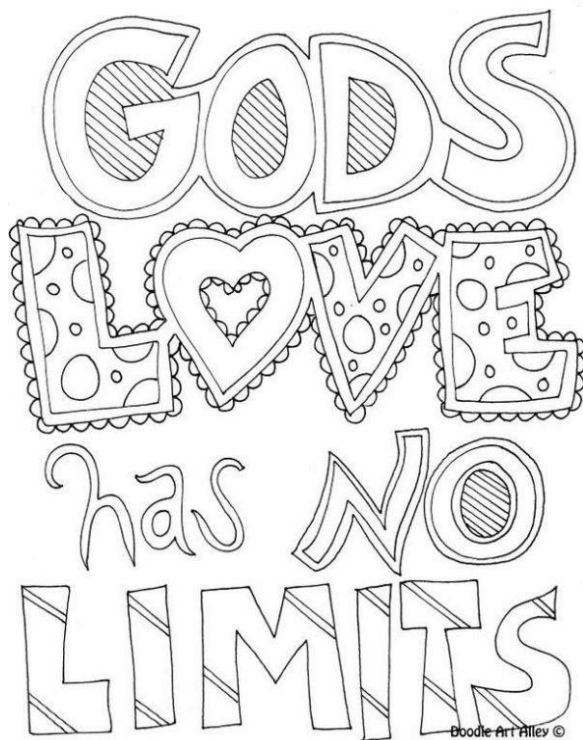
## SUNDAY SCHOOL NEWS
